ucas knew that he had to get away. He had to take their child, and he had to go back to Australia. There, he knew, they'd be safe from the destruction that seemed to hang around his wife, little Georgia's mother. Love may be unbounded, but care and forgiveness have their limits. Lucas had used up the last few drops of kindness. He sold the car for cash and took his daughter to the other side of the globe, far from the madness, far from the turmoil, far from his love.

Six days into this escape, word reached him that his wife was in a coma in a hospital in Wimbledon. So, while care and forgiveness had left him, the love remained. He returned to England.

The doctor that met him told him that his wife was brain-dead, and that she would not recover. When she had found her husband gone, she'd moved in with her friend. This friend, Jon, had

come home one afternoon to find her lying at the foot of the stairs.

It wasn't the first time that she'd fallen. In 1978, she'd fallen downstairs at her parents' cottage in Cornwall. To cope with the ensuing pain, she'd been prescribed painkillers which were known not to go down well with alcohol. Unfortunately, booze was one of the few friends left in her life. It was such a constant friend, in fact, that it kind of pushed her down another set of stairs in the next month. This latest fall, along with the sheer pain of trying to love her, had been the stimulus that finally convinced Lucas to leave.

And now he was back, beside her bed as she lay in a coma.

"Sandy," he said, as he held her still hand. "Why?"

She died two days later, without regaining consciousness, at the age of 31. And thus ended a tumultuous life that had created tender beauty and had caused awful sorrow.

Sandy Denny was born in 1947 in Wimbledon. As a teenager, she trained as a nurse, but, with a passion for music, she studied at an art college and fell in with folk musicians. These days, such a move might not seem so threatening. It's not the fate that parents dread for their beloved offspring. But in the mid-60s, this was a rebellious circuit, much given to sin and vice and all that other dreadful stuff

At a concert at The Troubador. she was spotted by The Strawbs, an up-and-coming band, and she was invited to record with them. I can't find those recordings anywhere, and God knows I've tried, but I daresay they sound rough and ready. But Sandy slipped in a song of her own, the painfully ethereal "Who Knows Where the Time Goes?" I challenge you to sit yourself down and listen to the haunting voice of the departed Denny, singing

her own song – I challenge you not to get goosebumps when you hear that voice from the past.

The song was picked up by American folk star Judy Collins and Sandy had established herself. In 1968 she joined Fairport Convention, and appeared on three LPs, which shaped the future of British folk-rock music. I know a lot of people might not thank them for this singular contribution to our culture, but there it is.

She left the group in 1969, and here we may remark on the productivity of groups back then, of 3 albums inside 12 months. It's taken the wonderful Beyonce 8 years to do that, and she's one of the busier stars

Sandy wanted to pursue her own career, and gathered together the group Fotheringay, named after another of her achingly beautiful songs. Another in the group was her future husband, Trevor Lucas, he of the deathbed vigil.

Seemingly restless, she moved on again and embarked on a solo career, never quite finding whatever was the happiness she sought, whatever the channel she needed for her creativity.

Now free, she made music, wrote songs, toured, guested with Led Zeppelin, rejoined Fairport Convention briefly, married Lucas, and gave birth to Georgia. She loved her baby daughter but just as often she seemed to forget about her in boozy bouts of depression. Nothing could ever make her truly happy. Drugs and emotional turmoil dogged her every effort.

In 1978 she died in a Wimbledon hospital as a result of brain haemorrhage.




FAIRPORT CONVENTION IN 1969

Hit the sweet spot Apple tarte tativi

Serves 4 Preparation time 15 minutes Cooking time 30 minutes

Tarte tatin has an air of sophistication that brings with it a reputation for being difficult or time-consuming to make. In reality, it's uncomplicated and undemanding, especially if you use ready-rolled pastry.

Ingredients

- 75g ready-rolled puff pastry
- 35g caster sugar
- · 30g butter
- ¼ tsp vanilla extract
- · A small pinch of salt
- 140g baking apples (around 1 small apple), peeled, cored and cut into 1cm slices

To serve

 Whipped cream, ice cream or creme fraiche



Pol, One Portion recipes for people who eat, cook or live alone, but are tired of washing up, by Eleanor Wilkinson, out now, published Ebury Press, priced at £22, with photography by Dan Jones.

Method

- 1. Preheat the oven to 180°C, 160°C fan, gas mark 4.
- Unroll your pastry sheet and cut it into a circle the size of a castiron frying pan.
- 3. Add the sugar to your pan and heat over a medium heat. Don't stir it but let it melt, then gently swill it around the pan as it turns to liquid. It will start to caramelise and turn a golden colour, this will take 4-5 minutes.
- Once the sugar is golden, turn off the heat and add in the butter. Add in the vanilla and a small pinch of salt, and stir again to combine everything.
- 5. Once combined, place the apples on top of the caramel, arranging them in any way you like but trying to keep them in a single layer as much as possible. Lay the circle of pastry on top of the apples and tuck it around the edges of the pan slightly. Place in the oven and bake for 25 minutes or until the pastry is crisp and golden.
- 6. Once baked, take your serving plate and place it face down on top of the skillet. Carefully but confidently flip the plate and skillet over, turning out the tarte so the apples face upwards. Serve with whipped cream, ice cream or creme fraiche



As children go into their first or second year at secondary school, many parents will start being pressured to provide them with a smartphone because "everybody else has one".

They have a point: many kids conduct much of their social lives via phone apps, and don't want to miss out. But you know that there's a lot of unpleasant stuff online. The good news is that Apple and Android phones have some tools to help ensure your tween uses a smartphone safely.

On an iPhone, the features you want are in Settings > Family. Here you can set up Screen Time for family members, a feature enabling you to change safety settings for their phone and other devices. You can block specific apps, set time limits on others and set content restrictions.

The Android equivalent is an app called Family Link.

Screen Time and Family Link let you set content restrictions for the phone's default internet browser. The restrictions can't block everything, but they do a pretty good job of reducing the risk of dodgy content getting through, and you can also block specific sites.

Family Link and Apple's Find My app both enable you to locate your tween. In the case of Family Link, you can set up notifications regarding specific places, so for example you can get Google to ping you when your tween arrives at or leaves school or a friend's house.

These features will cover the basics for most people, but if you want even more control there are multiple parental-control apps from big names in computer security. One of the best known is Norton Family, which not only blocks content and does so even better than the Apple and Google apps but also enables you to see a child's search, streamed video and browsing history.



Aura

This US app was judged the best parental app by the tech site Techradar last year, thanks to its ability to warn you about dodgy content and other kids' bullying behaviour in games. **\$99 per year**



Net Nanny

Net Nanny's focus is on inappropriate content, enabling you to block and be alerted of attempts to view pornography and other unsuitable content. It's available for PC, Mac and iOS but not Android. **\$59 per year, netnany.com**



Norton Family

Norton is one of the best-known names in PC security and this cross-platform app runs on phones and computers with effective parental controls, app blocking, time limits and search history reporting. £14.99 per year, Norton.com



Qustudio

INSURANCE: BUY OR SAVE?

Some core insurance products are mandatory, but sometimes buying a policy isn't the only option.

You could consider 'self-insurance.' That means rather than take out a policy and pay premiums, you intentionally set money aside regularly and use this if and when you incur the costs. If you haven't made a claim at the end of each year, you can spend the money elsewhere or keep it in place to build up a bigger safety buffer.

At first glance this may look worthwhile as most insurance customers pay out more in premiums than they ever get back in payouts: that's how insurers make a profit. In reality, it's not always that simple.

Some insurances are mandatory, such as thirdparty cover for drivers or when your mortgage lender requires you to have buildings insurance. In other cases, the sheer sums at stake if you make a claim could be financially ruinous, such as a house fire if you didn't have contents insurance.

In other scenarios, the potential costs should be small enough that you don't face major cashflow problems – for example, if something goes wrong before you've built up enough savings. You also need to be extremely self-disciplined about saving and not raiding the pot for something else.



Pet insurance

One common area for self-insurance is for pet insurance. With premiums rising 20% annually on average, the risk-reward ratio isn't always favourable, particularly where policies have high excesses (the amount you pay yourself towards any claim). Many policies have limits on annual payouts or total payouts for a particular illness or injury. On the other hand, the self-insurance option means you could face an extremely high bill for a catastrophic injury or have to make some tough choices about your pet's future.



Breakdown cover

Roadside assistance or breakdown cover are forms of insurance that many people pass up. The only difference with self-insuring is that you actively put money aside in case you need to pay call-out fees or get a vehicle towed. To decide if this is worthwhile you need to look at the premiums (in other words, the membership fees), any limitations, and the realistic likelihood of your vehicle breaking down. Don't overlook the peace of mind of knowing you'll often get a quicker response if you have breakdown cover.

Boiler cover

Self-insurance for boiler cover can make sense with a newer, more reliable boiler, particularly if you could survive the cash-flow hit of an unlikely but expensive repair. Several surveys suggest it's roughly a 50-50 bet that a boiler will break down within its first six years. Check carefully to see what protection your home insurance policy gives you for a breakdown.





Appliance insurance

Finally, appliance insurance, often called an extended warranty, isn't always great value, even if the premiums seem reasonable. The real question is whether you'll get a full payout in the event of a breakdown or if exclusions and restrictions undermine the value.

HYUNDAI HYUNDAI Ioniq 5 N

What is it?

Hyundai's loniq 5 N is the 'hot' version of its standard electric hatchback with go-faster touches to make it more involving, exciting and engine-like than ever, but does it compare to other hot EVs?

What's new?

This first electric Hyundai N car is usable and exciting and features several driving modes to help on a track. There's a launch control function, bigger front brakes, and an N Active Sound system and N e-Shift to recreate the sound and feel of a traditional gearbox.

What's under the bonnet?

The 5 N's 84kWh battery has a claimed range of 278 miles, compared to 298 for the standard loniq. The loniq 5 N produces 609 bhp, while the NGB button on the steering wheel unlocks 641 bhp for 10 seconds.

0-60mph takes 3.5 seconds (3.4 with the NGB button) and the top speed is 161mph. All Ioniq 5 N's come with four-wheel drive.

What's it like to drive?

This is like no other electric car, and even the simulated internal combustion engine noises add to the fun factor.

Sharp and nimble steering combines well with the loniq 5 N's cornering and it doesn't feel like a tank to drive despite its weight. Acceleration is excellent while the 'gearshifts' really work – you can even 'hit' the rev limiter.

Ride comfort is adequate in Normal and Sport modes, but Sport+ mode makes the N very sharp over bumps. Steering gets quicker in Sport and Sport+ mode and you can change the fake exhaust noise.

On the negative side is the loniq 5's large size, especially with its larger body kit.

How does it look?

The N version has eye-catching style with Hyundai's flagship Performance blue paintwork, flared wheel arches, side skirts, front bumper lip and large rear spoiler.



Carbon and gloss black trim at the front and rear, 21-inch alloys and red accents on the lower part of the car help complete the traditional 'N' look.



What's it like inside?

The Ioniq 5 N has a sporty steering wheel with controls for different drive modes. The N sports bucket seats keep you in place and there are aluminium pedals and blue stitching throughout. The cabin is spacious with plenty of storage. The rear head and legroom are good and the doors open wide for easy access.

Boot space is 480 litres with the seats up and 1,540 litres with them down.

The interior quality isn't as good as other Hyundai products, with hard plastics used throughout – disappointing at this price.

What's the spec like?

The specification is excellent and includes the N Bucket seats and sporty steering wheel, 21-inch forged alloy wheels, digital key, rear electronic slip differential, Bose sound system and a 12.3inch touchscreen. Prices start at £65,000 and rise to £66,250.

The Hyundai is expensive compared to performance EVs like the Volkswagen ID.3 GTX and the MG4 XPower.

Verdict

Hyundai's loniq 5 N proves that an electric car isn't just a tool for getting around and it is a groundbreaking vehicle tailored to driving enthusiasts.

The driving experience and feel are unique and the N could break the ice between EV sceptics and full-blown car enthusiasts, despite the price.

The charm of the Channel Islands

Nestled between the UK and France, the Channel Islands have long been recognised for their holiday appeal. Owned by the British crown, but not actually part of the UK, they offer British tourists hopes of a warmer climate and a touch of the exotic, without the need to cross borders.

The archipelago is made up of five main islands, the largest and most populated being Jersey and Guernsey. Closer to the coast of Normandy than the UK's shores, the weather here tends to be milder. English and French are widely spoken, and although you'll see road signs and street names in French, most of the population speaks English. To top it off, the islands are easily accessible from many places in the UK. You can catch a ferry from Poole and Portsmouth to Jersey and Guernsey, and direct planes fly from airports such as Exeter, Birmingham, Manchester, Liverpool and Glasgow.

Inspired? Here are a handful of experiences to tick off while you're there.

Visit Jersey Zoo

Founded by writer and naturalist Gerald Durrell in 1959, Jersey Zoo is widely considered one of the best in the world. It also plays an important role in the conservation and breeding of species that are under threat, and their reintroduction into the wild.

Visit to see endangered creatures such as Andean bears, orangutans and lowland gorillas, and even stay overnight thanks to the zoo's unique camping programme.

Discover WWII relics

Between 1940 and 1945, the Channel Islands came under Nazi occupation, leaving behind sobering reminders of the horrors of WWII. These include the remains of the Lager Sylt concentration camp on the island of Alderney, the wartime memorabilia of Guernsey's La Vallette Underground Military Museum and – perhaps most poignantly – the Jersey War Tunnels, the remains of a Nazi underground hospital converted into an interactive museum.

Find your favourite beach

The Channel Islands have no shortage of sandy beaches to lay your towel on – in fact, some are so beautiful, you'll almost forget you're in the British Isles! On the island of Herm, the azure waters of Shell Beach wouldn't look out of place in the Caribbean. Then there's the sheltered Portelet beach in Jersey, which offers a perfect swimming lagoon at low tide.

Explore by foot

The Channel Islands offer a fantastic network of coastal pathways from which to soak up the islands' spectacular scenery. Walk along quiet clifftop paths, stopping to savour the scent of subtropical plants, and look out for cormorants, oystercatchers and even puffins if you're lucky. Along the way, you'll be treated to views of sandy bays, rugged cliffs, hidden coves and farmland dotted with Jersey cows.

Take to the water

Jersey was once the centre of Europe's surf scene, and the sport is still as popular as ever among locals. The three-mile stretch of St. Ouen's Bay on the west coast of the island remains one of Jersey's main surfing locations. Guernsey's surf scene is smaller, with most local surfers chasing the swell at Vazon Bay.
